

COUNSELOR JOB DESCRIPTION

PURPOSE:

1. To present the gospel of Jesus Christ according to the ability of the Guest to receive and understand it.
2. To influence his/her spiritual, physical and emotional life for Christ.

RESPONSIBLE TO:

Camp Director and/or Assigned Counselor (High School Juniors and Seniors)

Camp Director (College-Age or Experienced)

RESPONSIBLE FOR:

Assisting Counselors in the care of Guests as assigned or requested. (High School)

Any Counselor-In Training assigned to assist him/her. (College)

Any Guests assigned to his/her care. (College)

QUALIFICATIONS OF:

1. Must know Jesus Christ as personal Savior.
2. Must be dedicated to the service of Jesus Christ.
3. Must agree with our Statement of Faith.
4. Must have the ability and interest to care for people with disabilities.
5. Must have the ability to follow directions and work cooperatively with people.

DUTIES OF:

1. To direct the physical activities of Guests, including: crafts, exploring subjects of nature, recreation, hikes, etc.
2. To care for the Guests' personal needs, including: grooming, hygiene, bathing, medicine, etc.
3. To care for the emotional needs of Guests.
4. To direct the spiritual growth and development of Guests.
5. To prepare Guests for ministry opportunities and spiritual growth.
6. To follow the instructions given by Camp Director, Program Director and/or Lead Counselor.
7. To attend and participate in Counselor Training Week
